Immersive, authentic and educational, daily trips to the surrounding organic dairy farms provide guests with an insight into regional cheesemaking, while Saanegutsch's beer tours overlooking the countryside promise a memorable experience. Slow alfresco dining can be savoured with romantic farm table dinners prepared by Le Grand Bellevue's expert chefs, complete with intimate wine tastings, Swiss delicacies and pastoral folk traditions. Bucket list adventures don't stop there; this season Le Grand Bellevue's breezy hot air balloon rides will return, offering uninterrupted views over the charming chocolate box village with a picnic of freshly baked pastries and champagne for a sip in the sky.

HEALING MOUNTAIN WELLNESS

With nature-based activities at the heart, coolcations can be complete with one of Le Grand Bellevue's water-based activities, including a privately guided immersive wild swimming experience and stand-up paddle board yoga on the lake - allowing guests to both reconnect to themselves and the earth. Going far beyond traditional spa treatments and fitness experiences (which can both be enjoyed on-site), this summer Le Grand Bellevue will collaborate with Saanenland Tourism to launch a brand-new botanical hiking experience, allowing guests to forage for wild herbs and rare flowers, all while soaking up the scenic sights. Le Grand Bellevue re-launched in January 2014 after a year-long renovation by dynamic young owners, Daniel and Davia Koetser. In the heart of Gstaad village, the hotel was originally built in 1912 as a Cure House and Spa. Family-owned, managed and designed, the hotel comprises 57 bedrooms. Bold colours, eye-catching prints and elegant furniture make up the interiors. The hotel's signature restaurant LEONARD's offers exceptional fine dining overseen by Executive Chef Francesco de Bartolomeis (16 Gault Millau points), whilst the more intimate 18-seat Le Petit Chalet serves up a menu of hearty Swiss dishes. An on-site sushi bar serves up the freshest sushi in the Alps and other features include an art-deco bar and cocktail lounge, Cigar Lounge, Private Cinema and the Gstaad Yacht Club. Le Grand Bellevue is home to a 3,000 square metre subterranean spa in partnership with organic English brand, Bamford and Cellcosmet. Le Grand Spa features a Thermal Oasis, indoor swimming pool and outdoor relaxation pool, well-stocked fitness suite, comprehensive roster of complimentary fitness classes and expert in-house Personal Trainers, and Physiotherapists.
